SALT MARSH PLANTS
 South and Central Florida

Hibiscus grandiflorus
 3 m tall, large pink "hibiscus" flowers
 leaves 3 lobed, 10-20 cm long, up to 16 cm wide

Kosteletzkya virginica
 pink flowers, 3 lobed leaves

Samolus ebracteatus
 10-30 cm tall, flowers w 5 white to pink petals

Ipomoea sagittata
 succulent with alternate leaves, erect growth, flws blue, purple or white
 stems with sharp thorns; bright red fruit

Lycium carolinianum
 CHRISTMAS BERRY

Batis maritima
 SALT WORT
 succulent with opposite, cylindrical leaves, arching growth to 45 cm tall

Limonium carolinianum
 SEA-LAVENDER
 flower stalks up to 1 meter
 5 petals pale to dark blue leaves leathery 5-30 cm long, 3 cm wide

Sesuvium portulacastrum
 succulent with opposite, cylindrical leaves, prostrate growth, pink flowers
 pink flowers with 5 lobes, narrow opp. lvs

Iva frutescens
 MARSH ELDER

Solidago sempervirens
 SEASIDE GOLDEN-ROD
 FACW

Amaranthus australis
 SOUTHERN WATER HEMP

Suaeda spp.
 SEA BLITE
 succulent alt. lvs, fruit succulent

Borrichia frutescens
 SEA OXEYES
 seed head with spine tipped bracts
 forming large colonies; lvs grayish; flowers with spine tipped bracts

Baccharis angustifolia
 FALSE WILLOW

Baccharis halimifolia
 SALT BUSH
 FAC

Salicornia virginica
 GLASSWORT
 perennial to 30 cm tall, jointed stems turning red

Salicornia bigelovii
 GLASSWORT
 annual to 60 cm tall, jointed stems turning red

Hydrocotyle bonariensis
 Marsh Pennywort
 FACW

Phloxerus vermicularis
 SALTWEED, SILVERHEAD
 FACW
